Student-Athletes Receiving Athletic Scholarship*

There are four provisions whereby your athletic scholarship may be terminated:

- 1. Failing to meet the academic requirements of the College;
- 2. Failing to observe the training rules of the sport engaged;
- 3. Improper squad or school conduct during the full academic year; and
- 4. Failing to meet NCAA eligibility requirements for competition.

In addition, should your status as a member of the team change either by your voluntary withdrawal from team activities or by actions contrary to rules and regulations of the College, the respective sport conference and/or the NCAA, the College may terminate your athletic scholarship immediately.

In the event you receive financial aid awards in excess of the cost of attendance, the athletic scholarship may be reduced in order to comply with NCAA legislation governing financial aid to student-athletes.

This award is made in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution of the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) pertaining to the principles of amateurism, sound academic standards and financial aid to student-athletes. Your acceptance of the award means you agree with these principles and are bound by them.
